The start is the car park opposite the cricket pitch just outside Burley. The car park is free. From there we walk down to the cycle path which used to be the old Southampton and Dorchester railway line. We then walk along the cycle path past the Burbush car park and cross the road and walk over Church Moor. We then head up to Castle Hill and swing back round and head down into Burley. We can have lunch and then walk back to the car park which is a little out of the village. There is a nice church to visit very near the cricket pitch where all the best people get married.

The walk is a little under 5 miles and will take approximately 2 hours. There is one short steep hill and it can be quite muddy in places. We recommend walking boots or wellies.
